

Rules for Admission Procedures and Conditions for Admission to Doctoral Study Programmes at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering VSB-TUO for the Academic Year 2025/2026



This document is an English translation of the Czech document.

From 1 November 2024, the Dean of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering VSB-TUO announces the 1st round of the admission procedure for doctoral study programmes taught in English language and from 1 January 2025 for programmes taught in Czech language. At the same time, from 1 April 2025, it announces the 2nd round of the admission procedure for study programmes taught in English language and from 1 July 2025 2nd round of the admission procedure for study programmes taught in Czech language and at the same time 3rd round for study programmes in English language. The admission procedure is announced for the academic year 2025/2026, with the possibility to submit an application to the following study programmes:

*The maximum total number of students admitted for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd round of the admission procedure. If the capacity of the study programme in the given round of the admission procedure is filled, the study programme does not have to be open for further rounds.

There is no tuition fee for doctoral programmes taught in **the Czech language**.

The tuition fee for doctoral programmes taught in **the English language** is **500 CZK for each semester of study**.

Should no original seal be affixed on the initial page of a copy of this document by the administrator, the document is not a controlled document.

The main conditions for admission are:

- Graduating from a master degree programme or its equivalent.
- Achieving a weighted average grade (WAG) in a master degree programme of at least **78 points**, with graduates where WAG is not calculated, the admission committee decides on meeting this condition according to the study results or its equivalent. In exceptional cases, a student whose VSP not exceed this limit may be accepted.
- Passing the admission procedure.

The applicant may submit an application for study for a doctoral study without obtaining a master's or engineering degree, but this education must be documented by the deadlines specified in the paragraph The course of the admission procedure, which is part of this document.

Application procedure:

- The application form must be submitted electronically on the web portal of the university (<https://prihlaska.vsb.cz>), **no later than 28 February 2025 for the 1st round of the admission procedure for study programmes taught in English language. For the 1st round of the admission procedure for study programmes taught in Czech language and at the same time the 2nd round of the admission procedure for study programmes taught in English language, it is necessary to submit an application no later than 31 May 2025. For the 2nd round of the admission procedure to study programmes taught in the Czech language and at the same time the 3rd round of the admission procedure for study programmes taught in the English language, it is necessary to submit the application no later than 31 August 2025.** The application form must be completed in all sections. When completing, it is necessary to note the specific symbol generated by the EDISON information system for the particular application form, because it will be subsequently required for payment of the fee for admission procedure of 600 CZK. It is not necessary to print or send the application form nor any attachment to VSB-TUO. A medical certificate is not required.
- The applicant will choose a [framework topic of the dissertation thesis](#). The topics of the dissertations will be published on the website of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering **no later than 2 days before the opening of the given round of the admission procedure**. Supervisors propose dissertation topics to the guarantor of the doctoral study programme. The guarantor of the study programme cooperates with the head of the department on listing dissertation topics, according to the valid version of the document [TUO VP 19 001](#), art. 6, par. 5, let. r) and at the same time the head of the guaranteeing department is responsible for listing the topics of dissertations, according to art. 10, let. k. Applicants for doctoral studies may apply only for dissertation topics that are approved by the subject councils of the relevant study programmes. We recommend that candidates consult the selected topic of the dissertation in advance with the relevant supervisor and head of the department.
- To pay an administrative fee of 600 CZK. The fee is non-refundable at any stage of the admission procedure. The fee for the admission procedure is payable no later than 3 days after submitting the study application. **An unpaid application cannot be further administered in the system.**
- An essential part of the application form is a scanned copy of the diploma attesting the education of a master degree and a supplement to the diploma or final state examination certificate. **Applicants who will finish their studies in any of the follow-up master degree programmes at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering of the VSB – Technical University of Ostrava on the proper date of the Final State Examinations in the academic year 2024/2025 do not submit these documents, they will be submitted by the Study office of the Faculty. The other applicants must submit these documents no later than 3 March 2025 for the 1st round of the admission procedure for study programmes in English language. For 1st round of the admission procedure**

for study programmes in Czech language and at the same time the 2nd round for study programmes in English language, applicants must submit these documents no later than 3 June 2025. The deadline for the 2nd round of the admission procedure for study programmes in the Czech language and the 3rd round for study programmes in the English language is 1 September 2025.

- Other mandatory parts of the application form are: diploma supplement, structured curriculum vitae, a list of published and unpublished works (if any) and other documents proving the candidate's expertise (e.g. certificates of experience, certificates, language exams, etc.).
- The Dean of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering VSB-TUO may announce further rounds of the admission procedure in the academic year.

All required documents must be scanned or photographed in easy-to-read quality and must contain all pages. In the event of non-fulfillment of the above-mentioned procedures and conditions, the applicant's application will be excluded from the admission process.

The course of the admission procedure:

- For applicants who have duly submitted the application for the 1st, 2nd or 3rd round of the admission procedure with all the required documents, the Dean of the Faculty will decide on their admission on the basis of the recommendations of the admission committees appointed by him. Commissions may be appointed jointly for more than one study programme. The admission committee will assess the achievements in the (follow-up) master degree programme and the expertise in relation to the selected degree programme, the framework topic of dissertation thesis and language skills. The assessment will be based on submitted documents, i.e. WAG, CV, the list of published and unpublished works, alternatively other documents, and on the basis of an interview with the applicant which will be face-to-face or online. **As part of the interview with the applicant, knowledge of the English language will be assessed.** Applicants will be informed about the form and course of the interview well in advance in writing by letter or via the information system. For the 1st round of the admission procedure (for study programs in English), applicants will be invited to an interview no later than **14 March 2025**, no later than **13 June 2025** for the 1st round (for study programs in Czech) and at the same time the 2nd round of the admission procedure (for study programs in English) and at the latest until **8 September 2025** for the 2nd round of the admission procedure (for study programs in Czech) and the 3rd round (for study programs in English).
- The Commission evaluates applicants with a score of 0 to 100 points. The applicant can be admitted, if he/she achieves 51 out of 100 points. The date of the meeting of the admissions committee and interviews with applicants is for 1st round for study programmes in English is set for **17 March 2025**. For the 1st round for study programmes in Czech and at the same time the 2nd round for study programmes in English is set for **16 June 2025** and for the 2nd round for study programs in Czech and the 3rd round for study programs in English is scheduled for **10 September 2025**. In the event of a change in the date of the admissions committee meeting, the applicant will be informed well in advance. If the applicant does not appear for the interview without an apology or if his/her apology is not accepted, he/she will not be accepted for study. If the apology is accepted, the student can complete the interview in an alternate term, namely **24 March 2025** for the 1st round of the admission procedure (study programmes in English), **23 June 2025** for the 1st round (study programmes in Czech) and 2nd round (study programmes in English) and **12 September 2025** for 2nd round (study programmes in Czech) and 3rd round (study programmes in English). In exceptional cases, especially for foreign applicants, and with regard to the circumstances, may the admissions committee, at the applicant's request, decide on another alternative interview date.

- **Applicants will be ranked according to the number of points awarded by the admission committee and will be admitted from the highest value up to the maximum number of admitted students of the given degree programme. Admission of applicants takes place on the study programme and if more applicants are interested in the same framework topic of the dissertation, a positive decision on admission of these applicants is offered to applicants with a lower score another free topic, by mutual agreement between the applicant, supervisors and study programme guarantor. In case of achieving the same point gain, the topics are assigned on the basis of an agreement between the applicants, supervisors and the guarantor of the study programme.**

Applicants from abroad, or citizens of the Czech Republic completing master's studies abroad and applying for studies in the Czech language, must submit with the application for study:

- A document proving the fulfilment of the condition of duly completed studies in the (follow-up) master's study programme, if the education was obtained abroad (does not apply to equivalent documents, e.g. from the Slovak Republic). Procedure for assessing the evidence of completed education abroad is mentioned in the document „ASSESSMENT OF APPLICANTS' FOREIGN EDUCATION WITHIN THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE AT VSB – TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF OSTRAVA“ (document in the Czech language [TUO SME 20 003](#) and document in English [TUO SME 20 003](#)). If the assessment of previous education will take place as part of the admission procedure, the necessary documents (see <https://www.vsb.cz/en/university/university-services/recognition-of-foreign-education/>) must be delivered in paper form (address: VSB - TUO, FS, Dept. 301, 17. Listopadu 2172/15, 708 00 Ostrava-Poruba), no later than 30 days before the deadline for submitting all necessary documents by the applicant. After this deadline, the university no longer guarantees timely assessment of previous education.
- Certificate proving the knowledge of Czech on the level B2 (<https://www.vsb.cz/712/cs/kurzy-a-jazykove-zkousky/cestina-pro-cizince/>), (<https://www.vsb.cz/712/en/courses-and-exams/czech-for-foreigners/>). The document proving the required knowledge of Czech language has to be issued by a school given in the list of schools authorized to take the examination (Decree of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic 348/2008 Coll.).
- In the case of studying in English the applicant must provide a certificate proving knowledge of English on level B2. In cases worthy of special consideration, the Dean may waive this condition for the applicant.

In the case of a positive admission decision, and if the applicant has agreed to this in the application, the decision will be sent via the information system. Otherwise, the applicant will receive a written notification of acceptance / non-acceptance within 10 days after the date of the meeting of the admissions committee by consignment by hand, sent to the address specified in the application.

The applicant has the right to view all materials that are relevant for the decision on his/her admission to study within 15 days from the date of receipt of the decision of admission/rejection at the Study Department of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering. Copies of these materials are not available. The written request for review of the decision is governed by the Act on Higher Education (§ 50) and the Statute of the VSB – Technical University of Ostrava.
